ADDENDUM TO STANDING ORDER NUMBER 3

In response to the Current Judicial Declaration of Emergency, parties required to attend a program designed to educate themselves regarding shared parenting after separation or divorce may attend the class offered by Children of Divorce, Inc. via the Zoom platform. Parties desiring to attend another program shall follow the process outlined in Section “(c)” of the order to obtain prior approval of an unapproved class.

Certificates of completion shall be filed with the Clerk of Superior Court. Unrepresented parties should call the Superior Court Clerk in the county in which the civil action is filed to determine appropriate filing procedures at the time the certificate is obtained.
