
**ORDER REGARDING MERIWETHER COUNTY CRIMINAL NON-JURY
CALENDAR FOR MARCH 19, 2020**

In accordance with the Order Declaring Statewide Judicial Emergency of March 14, 2020, issued by Chief Justice Harold Melton, and the Coweta Circuit Order issued by Chief Judge John Simpson on March 16, 2020 the court hereby orders as follows:

- 1) Pursuant to the above-referenced orders, Defendants and their counsel who are out on bond should not appear for the Meriwether County Criminal Non-jury calendars on March 19th; and
- 2) Cases for Inmates on the March 19th calendar will be called and handled on a case by case basis. Inmates will not be brought over without permission of the court.
- 3) As stated in the above-referenced orders, the court remains open and any attorney that believes his client needs to be heard on an essential matter may contact the court to arrange for the matter to be heard on one of the scheduled court dates.
- 4) For any cases not resolved on March 19th or for Defendants out on bond, those cases are continued to April 23, 2020.

All other provisions of Justice Melton's and Judge Simpson's Orders remain in effect.
