Supreme Court Approves Civil Case Filing and Disposition Forms

ATLANTA – On November 14, 2017, the Supreme Court of Georgia approved new civil case filing and disposition forms as required by Senate Bill 132 (see O.C.G.A. § 9-11-133). As required by the law, the forms were first adopted by the Judicial Council of Georgia in October. The new forms will go into effect on **January 1, 2018** and will be hosted on the Supreme Court's Rules website (gasupreme.us/rules/).

The current forms are hosted on the Georgia Superior Court Clerks' Cooperative Authority's website (gsccca.org/file/civil-reporting-forms) and will be in effect through December 31, 2017.
